We are holding our Queen Elizabeth II Lawn Bowls Challenge this year on Saturday 8th of September at Partick Bowling Club. This is the fourth year we have run the event and it is an excellent fundraiser for us with 24 teams of 4 players competing from across Scotland. Last year's tournament managed to raise £6100 with over 150 people in attendance.

The RSEA began as an idea to raise a couple of hundred pounds to give a couple of old soldiers a day out at Ibrox has now raised almost £800,000 for the Ex service men and women looked after by Erskine. This would not have been possible without the help of a great team of volunteers organising events such as our Lawn Bowls Challenge.
